## USDA Designates 10 Massachusetts Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through <u>emergency loans</u>. Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation, or to refinance certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available, and repayment ability.

Impacted Area: Massachusetts

Triggering Disaster: Freeze occurring from 5/17/2023 – 5/18/2023

Application Deadline: March 11, 2024

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Berkshire, Bristol, Essex, Franklin, Hampden, Hampshire, Middlesex, Norfolk, Plymouth, Worcester

## **Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:**

Massachusetts: Barnstable, Dukes, Suffolk Connecticut: Hartford, Litchfield, Tolland, Windham New Hampshire: Cheshire, Hillsborough, Rockingham New York: Columbia, Dutchess, Rensselaer Rhode Island: Bristol, Newport, Providence Vermont: Bennington, Windham
